- We have been identified as Needs Substantial Intervention for these students, due to what appears to be a high dropout rate reflected in the data.
- It presents as 6 students out of 109 graduated in 2024.
- This is a difficult data to reflect with our model.
- Our SPED population is so low that much of the data is masked.
- However, we are rated as Meets Requirements for that data set.


